I had assumed that the "James Monroe Spier" house  
on page 139 was the Spier house on the old road near  
Boonville. If it is not, we did miss it.

Also, the "Samuel Spier" house on page 133 is east of  
Yadkenville on old Highway 421. It is behind this  
house that the Harding-Spier Cemetery is located  
where Ruth Cain Eddleman, wife of Samuel Spier is buried,  
Plus Wilkani Harding, wife Jane Spier Harding and most  
of their children. Please note, Luther Davis, whose  
grandfather bought the property, said the house use to be  
2 stories, but top story had been cut down. It is a  
very old place, and has a basement underneath.

Mr. Prather Eddleman, age 90, still lives near the Samuel  
Spier house. He descends from Ruth Cain's first marriage  
to Jacob Eddleman, I believe. He verified that the house
